Official CMC Rules

MGR rules to govern and to take precedence over all others for the MGR sanctioned shows

- 1. Goats must be registered by the Myotonic Goat Registry. The ORIGINAL registration certificate MUST accompany the goat during check-in.**
- 2. Age eligibility for classes will be determined by registration certificate.**
- 3. Substitutions will be allowed at Check-In within the same class at no charge.**
- 4. No percentage goats will be allowed to be shown.**
- 5. First show will start promptly at .**
- 6. Goats will be released immediately after the show.**
- 7. All goats MUST have a health certificate if not residing in California. Scrapie rules apply. If you use microchips, you must furnish a reader. Tattoos MUST be legible. Scrapie tags are acceptable. If you do not comply with scrapie rules you will be asked to remove your goats from the grounds. You MUST bring an extra copy of your goat's health certificate that will be retained by the show secretary.**
- 8. All goats must be shown with collar on. All goats must wear collars outside of stalls. Bucks must be secure at all times.**
- 9. Show secretary reserves the right to split large classes.**
- 10. MGR Rules to govern and to take precedence over all others.**
- 11. Entry fee: \$10.00 per goat per show. No refunds of entry fees.**
- 12. This is a ribbon and points show. Any available awards will be announced at the show.**
- 13. Private treaty sales will be allowed after the show.**
- 14. Private treaty sales allowed but all goats brought into the facility must be entered.**
- 15. Entries must be received no later than .**
- 16. Goats MUST be checked in by .on the day of the show. Check in times will be**
- 17. Any item that comes up that is not specifically covered by these rules will be decided by the show committee and their decision will be final.**
- 18. No alcoholic beverages or smoking in the barns or arena allowed.**
- 19. All goats entering California for exhibition must meet all the requirements for entry into California and must have a valid health certificate. Goats may be examined on grounds by show personnel or veterinarian. Goats showing evidence of disease, particularly foot rot, sore mouth, abscesses will not be allowed to enter the barn or show and may be released by officials.**

20. *The organizers of this show and the facility will not be liable for any loss, damages or accidents to animals, persons or property while participating in the show. Youth exhibitors are to be accompanied by a responsible adult.*

Class Schedule

Junior Handler Class (not MGR sanctioned)

Class 1 Junior Handler: Handlers aged 5 to 8 years of age

Class 2 Junior Handler: Handlers aged 9 to 19 years of age

Jr. Handlers will be judged on showmanship. The goat will not be judged. Jr. Handlers may show a doe or wether of any age. This class is unsanctioned and the winners are not eligible for championship awards.

MGR Junior Wether Division

Class 3 Kids: 6 months of age and under

Class 4 Jr. Yearlings: Over 6 months and under 12 months of age

MGR Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion Wether

Champion will be selected from the 1st place winners of classes 2-3. Reserve Champion will be selected from the remaining 1st place winners and the animal standing 2nd in the class from which the Champion was selected.

MGR Senior Wether Division

Class 5 Sr. Yearling: 12 months to under 24 months of age

Class 6 Senior Wether: 24 months of age and over

MGR Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Wether

Champion will be selected from the 1st place winners of classes 4-5. Reserve Champion will be selected from the remaining 1st place winners and the animal standing 2nd in the class from which the Champion was selected.

MGR Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion Wether

Grand Champion will be selected from the junior and senior Champion Wethers. Reserve Grand Champion will be selected from the remaining Champions and the Reserve Champion animal from which the Grand Champion was selected.

MGR Junior Doe Division

Class 7 Doe Kid: under 3 months of age

Class 8 Intermediate Doe Kid: 3 to under 6 months of age

Class 9 Sr. Doe Kid: 6 to under 9 months of age

Class 10 Advanced Doe Kid: 9 to under 12 months of age

Class 11 Yearling Doe: Unfreshened 12 to under 24 months of age - unfreshened)

MGR Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion Doe

Champion will be selected from the 1st place winners of classes 6-10. Reserve Champion will be selected from the remaining 1st place winners and the animal standing 2nd in the class from which the Champion was selected.

MGR Senior Doe Division

Class 12 Yearling Doe Sr.: Freshened 12 to under 24 months of age

Class 13 Two Year Old Doe: 24 to under 36 months of age

Class 14 Three Year Old: 36 to under 48 months of age

Class 15 Four Year Old and Older: 48 months and over

MGR Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Doe

Champion will be selected from the 1st place winners of classes 11-14. Reserve Champion will be selected from the remaining 1st place winners and the animal standing 2nd in the class from which the Champion was selected.

MGR Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion Doe

Grand Champion will be selected from the junior and senior Champion does. Reserve Grand Champion will be selected from the remaining Champions and the Reserve Champion animal from which the Grand Champion was selected.

MGR Junior Buck Division

Class 16	Jr. Bucks: under 3 months of age
Class 17	Jr. Bucks: 3 to under 6 months of age
Class 18	Jr. Bucks: 6 to under 9 months of age
Class 19	Jr. Bucks: 9 to under 12 months of age

MGR Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion Buck

Champion will be selected from the 1st place winners of classes 15-18. Reserve Champion will be selected from the remaining 1st place winners and the animal standing 2nd in the class from which the Champion was selected.

MGR Senior Buck Division

Class 20	Yearling Buck: 12 to under 24 months of age
Class 21	Sr. Buck: 24 to under 36 months of age
Class 22	Sr. Buck: 36 to under 48 months of age
Class 23	Sr. Buck: 48 months and over

MGR Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Buck

Champion will be selected from the 1st place winners of classes 19-22. Reserve Champion will be selected from the remaining 1st place winners and the animal standing 2nd in the class from which the Champion was selected.

MGR Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion Buck

Grand Champion will be selected from the junior and senior Champion bucks. Reserve Grand Champion will be selected from the remaining Champions and the Reserve Champion animal from which the Grand Champion was selected.
