Each year, members of 4-H, FFA, Grange organizations and Independent exhibitors raise livestock to be sold at the annual Kiwanis Junior Livestock Auction, held during the Antelope Valley Fair. Along with the responsibilities of caring for the animals, the individuals involved learn dedication and respect. They come to understand the rewards of hard work that comes with financial responsibilities.

Buyers range from large and small local business owners to corporate offices and families. In 2008, over 385 animals were eligible for the auction in several divisions including: Market Goat, Sheep, Beef, Swine and the Champion and Reserve Champion Chickens, Rabbits and Turkeys. This year's auction is Thursday, August 26, 9 a.m. and will include ALL market ready beef, sheep, swine, goats as well as Meat Pen Champions and the next two highest pen placing for chickens, turkeys and rabbits. III. Judges

7. To encourage high standards, the judge shall award first, second, third place, etc. according to merit. If without merit, the judge shall make no award under any circumstances. The judge may award championships or other awards at his/her discretion for superior exhibits. This applies whether there are one or more exhibits in class.

If the day of show class size numbers do not warrant a large enough class size, organizations can be combined per superintendent approval.

DIVISION 1-5

Market Goats must be individually owned 60 days prior to opening day of the Fair. Goats must be free of horns (Scurs less than 1 inch **at the longest point**). **This will be strictly ENFORCED.** Does cannot show any udder development. All males must be castrated. Goat hair **MUST BE** trimmed to 3/8" (**Head to tail above the hocks MUST be trimmed**). Market Goats showing yearling teeth or lice will be disqualified.
