Thursday, August 19th

Beef, Sheep, Goat to be immediately weighed in after vet check (DNA Samples from all randomly selected animals will be conducted at this time) A parent/legal guardian or leader MUST be present at DNA pull and sign DNA forms. Over and under animals will automatically be re-weighed. The animal that is to be re-weighed MUST NOT leave the scale area. Animals not meeting the specific weight requirements must be removed from the grounds immediately if not ALREADY registered for Showmanship
