- Scholarships – Diane Williams would like the committee to meet to revise the applications. Candice Vander Hyde would like to be a part of the committee.

SHOW PROPOSALS FOR 2021 LIVESTOCK SHOW:

Market Swine Show Proposal:

- Friday August 13th 6:00pm-9:00pm
 - Receive and weigh at time of unloading
- Saturday August 14th 8:00am
 - Show Starts with Swine Showmanship- Independent, FFA, Grange, 4-H (Senior, Junior, Novice)
 - Followed by Market classes- Independent, FFA, Grange, 4-H
 - Followed by Bred and Fed
 - Followed by Supreme Champion Drive
- Wednesday August 25th Time: TBD
 - Swine return for auction
- The swine will be reweighed when brought in for auction. If they have lost more than 4% from show weight, then they will not be eligible for the auction. THIS MEANS YOU MUST KEEP FEEDING THEM UNTIL AUCTION.
- The AV Fair will provide water and lixits in all swine pens.
- Pens will be assigned after weigh in. Exhibitor will have the same pen for show day and auction day.

- Exhibitor will be responsible for shavings for their pen. When hauling out on Saturday pen must be clean of all manure, clean shavings may remain in pen.
- Release form is required to haul any animal out.
- Exhibitor is responsible for feeding swine August 13 & 14, 25 & 26

Market Beef Show Proposal:

- Sunday August 15, 2021 haul in from 6:00 am to 9:00 am. Animals will go to the scale and weigh at time of unloading.
- Wash racks will be available to wash animals but, there can be no feeding in the wash racks.
- Showmanship will start at approximately 10:30 am and will be followed by the Market classes, Bred and Fed, and then Supreme Champion.
- You may bring in your Beef equipment Saturday August 14, 2021.
- The day of the Beef Show there will be no bedding allowed.
- All areas Must be clean and free of all manure, hay and trash before you live the fairgrounds, or a \$20.00 cleaning fee will be charged for each animal.
- Power boxes will be set up and available for use.
- There will be assigned tie stalls for each animal. This will be done by clubs.
- The picture back drop will be set up in the beef barn for you to take pictures.
- You will need to pick up a release form before leaving the fairgrounds after the show.
- The animals will be weighed on the day of the show and the day you haul them in to be auctioned. If they have lost more than 3% then they will not be eligible for the auction. THIS MEANS YOU MUST KEEP FEEDING THEM UNTIL THE AUCTION.

Market Sheep Show Proposal:

- Saturday, August 21st haul in between 6am - 8am. Lambs will be weighed in right after Vet Check off the trailers.
- Order of Lamb Show is as followed:
 - 9am Market Classes (Independent, FFA, Grange, 4H)
 - Showmanship Classes (Independent, FFA, Grange, 4H)
 - Bred & Fed Class
 - Supreme Champion
- Wash racks will be available to wash animals. There will be NO feeding of any animals in the wash racks.
- You may load in your lamb equipment on Friday August 20, 2021 (Load in equipment time to be determined).

- The day of the Lamb Show, there will be No bedding allowed.
- All areas Must be clean and free of all manure, hay and trash before you leave the fairgrounds, or a \$20.00 cleaning fee will be charged for each animal.
- There will be assigned pens and this will be done by clubs.
- You will need to pick up and fill out a Release Form before leaving the fairgrounds after the Lamb Show.
- Lambs will be weighed on the day of the Lamb Show and the day you haul them in to be auctioned on Wednesday, August 25th.

Market Goat Show Proposal:

- Sunday August 22, 2021 haul in from 6:00am to 9:00am. Animals will go to the scale and weigh at the time of unloading.
- Wash racks will be available to wash animals, BUT there can be NO feeding in the wash racks.
- Show Order: Market, Bred and Fed, Supreme Champion, Showmanship
- Show to start at approximately 10:30am
- The day of the Goat Show there will be no bedding allowed.
- All areas must be clean and free of poop, feed, and trash before you leave the fairgrounds, or a \$20.00 cleaning fee will be charged for each animal.
- There will be assigned pens for all clubs.
- The picture backdrop will be set up in the practice arena in the Goat Barn for you to take pictures.
- You will need to pick up a release form at the entry office before leaving the fairgrounds.
- The goats will be weighed on the day of the show and the day you haul them in to be auctioned. If they have lost more than 3% then they will not be eligible for the auction. THIS MEANS YOU MUST KEEP FEEDING THEM UNTIL THE AUCTION.

Small Animal Show Proposal:

- *Junior Utility Meat Chicken and Meat Turkey Show:*
 - Wednesday August 25th 7am-11am all poultry will be brought in and inspected upon arrival.
 - Entry fee: \$15
 - Meat turkey entries limit will be 50
 - All standing rules apply
 - Approximately 11:30am Market show begins

- All poultry are released following the show, except champions and reserve champion and next two highest placing lots will stay sell at auction. All birds not picked up at appointed time will become property of the AV Fair
- *Chicken Showmanship:*
 - No open poultry show.
 - Entry fee: \$10
 - 1pm showmanship birds are brought in and inspected, birds must stay with exhibitor at all times.
 - 2pm Youth showmanship show, located in the beef practice arena.
 - Exhibitors may bring 2 show birds
 - Exhibitors must provide water for their birds.
 - Ribbons/Trophy (waiting on a quote)
 - Showmanship Buckles (waiting on a quote)
- *Dog Show:*
 - No AKC sanction.
 - Entries: \$15 each.
 - Requesting the same day as beef show. There will be no conflict with the kids who show beef and those who show dogs.
 - Held out on the grass area. We will provide shade. No need for a building.
 - Classes:
 - Obedience, rally, showmanship, tricks
 - 2 judges (no cost - there are a few volunteers)
 - Ring equipment- \$60
 - Ribbons/ trophy (waiting on a quote)
 - Showmanship Buckles (waiting on a quote)
 - Will be able to still pay premiums.
- *Pygmy Goat Show:*
 - Pygmy goat youth show only (with sanction)
 - Also request the same day as the beef show since there is no conflict.
 - Show in the swine practice/ holding arena.
 - One judge
 - Entry fee: \$15 each.
 - Traditional classes & showmanship.
 - Exhibitors clean their own pens.
 - All areas MUST be clean and free of all manure, hay trash, or a \$20.00 cleaning fee will be charged per animal.
 - Ribbons/ trophy (waiting on a quote)

- Showmanship Buckles (waiting on a quote)
- Will be able to still pay premiums.
Sanctioned show will cost \$300. We have a sponsor for the sanctions
