Motion to excuse absent members of the board: James Lane made a motion to excuse Dr Nyholt – 2nd Vice Chair, Marlene Mattison -Sheep Chairperson, and Shaun Smith- Sheep Chairperson. Motion seconded by Connor Markley. Motion passed.

Public Comment – None

Approval of June 2022 Minutes – A motion was made by Travis Markley to approve the June minutes and was seconded by Nathan Corpuz. Motion passed.

Finance Report – No change in the JLA account. Barn Bash account had expenses of \$5,487.68 of which \$3,445.81 was for dinner, \$2,041.87 for dinner tickets, dessert supplies, etc. leaving a balance of \$22,729.22. This total does not include monies made during the Barn Bash Event.

New Business:

- Swine Barn setup- Nathan Corpuz has set the pen setup for July 30th beginning at 7:00 am. He will have pen assignments posted at the setup. He needs to know how many Kids Feeding Kids pigs their will be so they will have their pens ready.
- Arena setup- James Lane set the arena setup for July 30th beginning at 7:00 am. He is hoping that we will be able to have enough volunteers to setup both the show arena and the swine barn in a timely manner.
- Scholarship Committee – Diane Williams would like to set the scoring date for Friday August 5th at 6:30 pm. She will check with everyone to make sure that date and time will work for everyone.
- Auction Dinner- Candice Vander Hyde presented three options for the dinner. Tony Ferman made a motion to go with option C (Option C: Council would need to recruit volunteers or hire a caterer to prep, cook, and serve all food. Council volunteers would manage selling tickets, both in advance and onsite) with a limit of 600 dinners total. 450 tickets for sale at \$12.00 a plate and 150 dinners for the buyers. James Lane seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Old Business:

- Barn Bash – Paula Markley listed totals for money brought in that evening \$36,735.00. Tickets sold by clubs and individuals \$10,565.00. Gun Raffle Money \$2,630.00. Credit Card payment's \$700.00. Total is \$50,630.00.
- Paula Markley handed out a list of sponsors needed for the 2022 Livestock show. We need to get as many sponsors as possible to cut down on the out-of-pocket expenses. Paula asked Mrs. Wiesenberger if she would still do the champion blankets for auction again this year. She is waiting to hear back from the florist.
- Diane Williams asked for clarification on the volunteer schedule and what was needed from the barn chairs. Dan Jacobs said he needed a schedule that showed who was working and what hours that they were there to be signed off by the barn chairs.
- James Lane asked that we have Betty Smith honored in our auction catalog. Diane Williams made a motion to have Betty Smith our auction catalog honoree. Dannon Shaughnessy seconded the motion. Motion passed. Dan Jacobs will help get the bio on Betty and get it to the council.

Adjournment:

Motion was made by James Lane to adjourn the meeting, Connor Markley seconded the motion, motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 pm
