Motion to excuse absent members of the board: Paula Markley made a motion to excuse Travis Markley – Beef Chairperson, Connor Markley- Goat Co-Chairperson, Melissa Love Goat Co-Chairperson, Dannon Shaughnessy- Sm Animal Co-Chairperson, and Dotty Snyder-Sm Animal Co-Chairperson. Motion seconded by Scott Clarl. Motion passed.

Finance Report – Tony Ferman reported that the Barn Bash account's income was \$63,583.00, expenses were \$16,529.29, Balance is \$75,269.94. The JLA account's income was \$64,791.69, expenses were \$44,219.37, Balance \$74,971.23. RMS account balance is \$48,642.99.

Thursday August 17th

7am-9 am Vet Check for Beef, Sheep, Goat, and Swine; All Species required, done at barns BEFORE off-loading. *Swine, Barrow, Sheep & Goat to be immediately weighed in after vet check** (DNA Samples from all randomly selected animals will be conducted at this time). A parent/legal guardian or leader MUST be present at DNA pull and sign DNA forms. Over and under animals will automatically be re-weighed. The animals that are to be reweighed MUST NOT leave the scale area. Animals not meeting the specific weight requirements must be removed from the grounds immediately if not ALREADY registered for Showmanship and/or Barrow Show.

5pm-8pm Vet Check for Beef, Sheep, Goat, and Swine; All Species required, done at barns BEFORE off-loading. *Swine, Barrow, Sheep & Goat to be immediately weighed in after vet check** (DNA Samples from all randomly selected animals will be conducted at this time). A parent/legal guardian or leader MUST be present at DNA pull and sign DNA forms. Over and under animals will automatically be re-weighed. The animals that is to be reweighed MUST NOT leave the scale area. Animals not meeting the specific weight requirements must be removed from the grounds immediately if not ALREADY registered for Showmanship and/or Barrow Show. - Dan Jacobs gave us the dates for the April 2024 Poppy festival which will be held April 19th, 20th and 21st, and Livestock Auction to be held on April 25th 2024. The livestock complete schedule will be announced at a later date.
- Jeff Briggs announced the Beef Safety walk dates as March 18th and April 1st 2023. They will start at 9am by appointment only. Contact Ginger O'Donnell or Linda Erb to make an appointment. Beef DNA deadline is April 20,2023.

Old Business:

- By-Laws- Julie Briggs stated that all livestock council members had received a copy of the revised By-laws and had an opportunity to look them over and any questions or changes needed to be submitted in writing. Tony Ferman sent in a list of punctuation corrections which were addressed. Jennifer Cloud made a motion to except and adopt the revised By-laws as written. Terry Williams seconded the motion. Motion passed and By-laws will be adopted and posted on the Fair website.
