Motion seconded by Scott Clark. Motion passed.

Approval of the February 2023 Minutes – Paula Markley made a motion to accept the minutes the motion was seconded by Jeff Briggs. No discussion, Motion passed.

Finance Report – Tony Ferman reported that there was no change to the accounts.

New Business:

- Committees- Julie Briggs asked that all committee’s begin meeting to plan the August show. Reports need to be emailed to Terri Hartman so they can be sent out before our general meeting.
- Sponsors- The council needs to start finding sponsors for the August fair. All checks received should be made out to Friends of the Fair and list in the memo what it is for, example: Barn Bash, Judges, Auction so the money will go into the correct account.
- Barn Bash- Jennifer Cloud reported that Dan Jacobs would like to see the Barn Bash renamed the Dr. Jim Nyholt and Betty Smith Barn Bash for the two people who contributed so much to this event. Terri Hartman made the motion to change the name to Dr. Jim Nyholt and Betty Smith Barn Bash. The motion was seconded by Jennifer Cloud. There was no further discussion, motion passed. Jennifer Cloud will have all the club books ready and at the front office by Friday March 10th for pick up by clubs.
- Livestock Judges – A Livestock Judge committee has been form to look into hiring judges for the livestock show. This committee members are Jennifer Cloud, Brian Gorrindo, Jeff Briggs, and Melissa Love. It was decided by this committee that for the 2023 fair, that they would like the fair to hire the judges due to the lateness of the year. They asked that the judges for Beef, Sheep, Swine, and Goat be hired from out of state. Jennifer Cloud stated that the fair is willing to cover a certain amount for the judges however the council will need to raise money to

cover the rest. The committee will find the judges for the 2024 April fair. Jennifer Cloud made a motion for the council to raise money for the extra cost to hire judges. Paula Markley seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. Motion passed.

- Bred and Fed Forms - Ginger O'Donnell has been able to put the forms online. They will have to be downloaded, filled out and then uploaded back to the fair. This should make the process much easier. Beef offspring paperwork is due April 20, 2023 and sheep, swine, and goat is due on June 19, 2023.
- Julie Briggs announced that Travis Markley has resigned as Beef Chairperson and that Derrick Hartman has been appointed as the new Beef Chairperson.
- Exhibitors Meeting has been scheduled for June 8, 2023 at 6:00 pm. Everyone was reminded that 3-18 and 4-1 were the beef safety walks and that appointments need to be made with Ginger by calling the office or emailing her. The brand inspector will be there at the 3-18 safety walk. Kevin McKenzie will be at the fairgrounds for hoof trimming on April 15th starting at 8:00 am. Cost will be \$60.00.
