CLASS:

1. (One) Birdhouse: Made from upcycled items or wood. Must be assembled and decorated by a Scout.
2. Pinewood Derby Car – should have 4 moveable wheels, decorated by Scout, kit may be used as a starting point.
3. Sit Upon, a traditional item used as a seat made by the Scout.
4. Leather Work: Scout made leather items- Belts, Coin purses, Wallets, and Bookmarks.
5. Higher Award – (Eagle, Bronze, Silver, or Gold Awards) – Entry should include a poster with Title, pictures, and an explanation of the project. Maximum size poster 22x28 inches.

RULES FOR DIVISION 2:

1. One entry per Troop
2. Gather photos or drawings on a mat board or poster board no larger than 22" x 28". Be sure to leave enough space on the board for a title and a 5"x7" card describing your project and why it is your favorite.
3. On the front of the board, include ONLY your Troop number, level, and city. Do not include names.
4. Identification must be securely attached to the back of each project. Include Troop number, Troop level, council name, leader's name, address, and phone number.
5. Entries that do not follow the guidelines as listed will be disqualified and will not be displayed.
6. Entries will be judged on Neatness, appearance, and meaningfulness.
7. Eligible projects must have been completed since the previous year's fair entries closed.
