PLEASE NOTE.

There is a NEW grading system for applications, and we encourage all high school senior and first year college students that are raising a market livestock animal to apply.

CRITERIA

For your application to be considered the following items are required:

- 1. Recipient must be a current exhibitor in 4-H, FFA, Grange group, or an Independent exhibitor limited to livestock department.
- 2. An Applicant is required to raise a market animal for the 2025 AV Fair & Event Center Livestock Show.
- 3. An Applicant must submit a current copy of high school or college transcripts and maintain a cumulative high school or freshman year of college 3.0 GPA or higher.
- 4. An essay with a minimum of 250 words but not exceeding 500 words telling us of your long-term goals and past accomplishments.
- 5. Character reference letters from 2 people who are not immediate family.
- 6. Winners will be announced during the Antelope Valley Fair & Event Center Livestock Show Grand Drive.
- 7. Checks will be awarded once recipient has turned in proof of enrollment into a college or trade school.
- 8. All applications must be completed and have been signed by the applicant and parent/guardian to be considered.
- 9. Application must be received on or before Friday, March 21, 2025, 5pm to the front office of the Antelope Valley Fair & Event Center to either Linda or Ginger. Applications can be submitted in person or via email. (<u>linda@avfair.com</u>)

PROCEDURE

- 1. Application MUST be legible.

- 3. The applicant must submit a current unofficial copy of their transcripts with scholarship application.
- 4. <u>Incomplete application will have points deducted during the scoring.</u>

- 2. The applicant will be scored and graded on a point-based rubric. (The rubric is provided, please look to understand how to fill out the application.
