- 4. ORNAMENTS, DECORATIONS AND TREE SKIRT MUST BE MADE OR EMBELLISHED BY EXHIBITOR. MUST HAVE A WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF HOW YOU EMBELLISHED OR MADE YOUR ORNAMENTS TO INFORM THE FAIR VIEWER.
- 5. An 8" x 10" framed description of the tree must be included with each exhibit.
