Scouts name and unit # should be on back of every entry. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SCOUT MADE

RULES FOR DIVISION 1 and 2:

1. One entry per Scout; per class. Only 1 division eligible, based on grade for 2026-2027 scout year
2. Scouts MUST adhere to the Guide to safe scouting and only use the appropriate tools under supervision.
3. No previously submitted entries will be accepted.

DIVISION 1 (22001)- Jr Level (Grades TK-5 for the 2026-2027 school year)

Scout Individual – Jr Level (Grades TK–5) One entry per person per class.

CLASS:

1. Camp Cooking; Desserts. Submit your favorite camp friendly dessert recipe. Include a 4x6 picture of the final product. Must be written legibly and in recipe format. Recipe should not be bigger than an 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper inclusive of the picture. Preferably recipe can be written on a 3x5 index card plus picture.
2. Recycled Sun Catchers – Sun catchers should be able to hang and no bigger than 12' wide and 18" long; inclusive of all things that may dangle off. It must be made of recycled materials or materials from nature.
3. Pinewood Derby Car – should have 4 moveable wheels, kit may be used as a starting point. Preferably the car used at this year's derby race, not required. Previous entries will be disqualified.
4. S.W.A.P.S. Board – A minimum of 5 S.W.A.P.S attached to a board no larger than 10 inches by 10 inches.

DIVISION 2 (22002)- Sr Level (Grades 6-12 for the 2026- 2027 school year)

Scout Individual – One entry per person per class.

CLASS:

1. Camp Cooking; Entree. Submit your favorite camp friendly main course recipe. Include a 4x6 picture of the final product. Must be written legibly and in recipe format. Recipe should not be bigger than an 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper inclusive of the picture. Preferably recipe can be written on a 3x5 index card plus picture. Each Recipe should contain at least 1 protein, 1 dairy, 1 fruit, 1 vegetable and 1 whole grain. (previously referred to as the "MyPlate guide")
2. Recycled Sun Catchers – Sun catchers should be able to hang and no bigger than 12' wide and 18" long; inclusive of all things that may dangle off. It must be made of recycled materials or materials from nature.
3. Pinewood Derby Car – should have 4 moveable wheels, kit may be used as a starting point. Preferably the car used at this year's derby race, not required. Previous entries will be disqualified.
4. S.W.A.P.S. Board – A minimum of 5 S.W.A.P.S attached to a board no larger than 10 inches by 10 inches.

DIVISION 3- Individual Higher Awards-. **AOL, Bronze, Silver, Gold, Eagle projects.**

Entry Fee, Premiums, Exhibits Received, and Exhibits Released are the same as above.

RULES FOR DIVISION 3:

1. One entry per Scout.
2. Gather photos or drawings on a mat board or poster board no larger than 22" x 28". Be sure to leave enough space on the board for a *title* and a *5"x7" card* describing your project.
3. Entries will be judged on neatness, appearance, and meaningfulness.
4. Eligible projects must have been completed during or after the 2025 Fair start date of September 24th
5. **There will be no Best of Division in this division.** Awards may be sponsored by local businesses.

DIVISION 3 (22003)- Individual Higher Awards

Scout Individual – One entry

CLASS:

1. Many scouts have done amazing projects for our communities. Helping others in big and small ways is one of the best things about being in Scouts. Using photos, drawings, and words, tell us about your Higher Award Project. For AOL only, the poster can showcase the most memorable event in their scouting journey.

DIVISION 4 – Troop/Pack- Community Service Project -. **OPEN TO ALL TROOPS**

Entry Fee, Premiums, Exhibits Received, and Exhibits Released are the same as above.

RULES FOR DIVISION 4:

1. One entry per Troop.
2. Gather photos or drawings on a mat board or poster board no larger than 11" x 14". Be sure to leave enough space on the board for a *title* and a *3x5 index card* describing your project and why it is your favorite.
3. On the front of the board, include ONLY your Troop number, level, and city. Do not include names.
4. Entries will be judged on Neatness, appearance, and meaningfulness.
5. Eligible projects must have been completed after September 2025.
6. **There will not be a Best of Division in this division.** Awards will be sponsored by local businesses.

DIVISION 4 (22004)- Troop/Pack- Community Service Project

One Entry Per Unit

CLASS:

1. Community Service Project – Poster maximum size 11x14 inches. Requires: Title, Troop or Pack identification, pictures and captions explaining project.
